The board chair Sook Bonin delivered the opening remarks, and there was a report of the KAAM programs and its accounting, and financial audit report. The vice president Mehee Coolidge was unanimously elected as the 51st President of the KAAM. She delivered her acceptance speech as the new president.

Lastly, a silent auction was held during the meeting, and the KAAM VOICE had a voter's rights campaign. Many participants were interested in and promised to register to vote. Centennial Anniversary March 1st Independence Movement

Deacon Chang-Jae Lee

3.1 Independence Movement; Declaration of Independence

In March 1st of 1919, thousands of people read aloud the Declaration of Independence against the Japanese colonial rule and started marching through the street shouting "Manse!".

3.1 Independence Movement; the largest participants

Participation in the March 1st Independence Movement was by people from all walks of life, including uneducated, young and old people. Even Koreans around the world participated. The March 1st movement marked the most civilian participation in Korea's history.

3.1 Independence Movement; Non-violence movement

The March 1st Independence Movement was carried out peacefully, and without recourse to violence. The spirit of democracy, peace, and non-violence of the March 1st Independence Movement was the beginning of the non-violence and non-resistance movement against colonials' governments and foreign powers.

3.1 Independence Movement; March 1st Revolution

The British Revolution, the American Revolution, the French Revolution, the Russian Revolution, the Xinhai Revolution. What these had in common is that the kingdom is abolished and a nation of the people is created. March 1st Independence Movement is the movement of the national spirit that abolished the monarchy and established the republic.



3.1 Independence Movement changed the ethos of the people

After the March 1st Independence Movement, the overall atmosphere of the Korean peninsula had changed. It had a great impact on the young generation. Social and media activities became more active, and many people went abroad for the independence movement. The energy obtained from the March 1st Independence Movement emerged as an expression of pride and a pride of self-sovereignty.

The Korean Provisional Government, the Birthplace of the Korean Independence Movement

The Korean Provisional Government was established by Korean independence movement activists in Shanghai, China in 1919. They organized the Provisional Legislative Assembly and launched the Korean Provisional Government as a democratic republic form of government.




