

Information about Nationality Detachment for Multi-nationality Citizens

- A military service obligation occurs to Korean men who were born in the United States / Canada when they become 18 years old under the Constitution and the Military Service Law.
- Multi-nationality citizens residing outside of Korea can notify a nationality detachment through the overseas diplomatic offices between the time of birth and the end of March of the year when 18 years of age is reached. If not, unless the military service is done or exempted, the nationality detachment will be restricted until the age of 37.

Dr. SungKyun Juhn won Seo Jae-pil Medical Award



On December 5th 2017, the University of MN Professor SungKyun Juhn won the 14th Seo Jae-pil Award. He graduated from Kyungpook National University medical school in 1957 and received his masters degree at Seoul National University (biochemistry) and his doctoral degree from the University of Düsseldorf in German (biochemistry). He is a professor of neuroscience at the University of Minnesota and a world-renowned professor.

Dr. Juhn is also recognized as a true medical practitioner of Schweitzer 's Life Outreach Thoughts. His unlimited dedication and effort has a great influence on many scholars and colleagues.

Dr. SungKyun Juhn was the president of KAAM in 1969 and he has been the president advisory board member since 2012.

The Admirable Mother Award

A Mother is who always with us

(KeumWha Choi, 2017 awardee)

What should a mother be to her child?

What was my mother to me?

My mother had to go through the Japanese colonial period and lived an uncertain life in the Korean War. She raised her seven children in a life of suffering and in fear of the future.



Whenever she told me her story of hard times, I found the path to lead my own life. I grew and learned from the stories that my mother told me and lived with her life philosophy. These philosophies had become the cornerstones of my life and I believe that a mother's life directly shapes that of her child's.

What kind of insight can we give to our children who have to live with many burdens?

The philosophy of life that I want to pass to my child is that the burden of life should not be feared. Instead, as my mother said, the burden of life could be a worthy gift.

A mother is the most trustworthy person. She is the one who gives us the courage to get through the trials, the one who we can laugh with and cry with. A mother is not only a person who teaches her children properly, but also a person who is always with them.

Admirable Mother Award

This award was established to honor the life of Mrs. Kyong-ja Lee(1915-2005) and will be awarded to single mothers who follow her footsteps. Mrs. Lee at age of 34 during the Korean War became a widow with 4 children. She had to overcome indescribable hardships in order to raise her children. She dedicated her whole life to raise them.
