MKF 2023 was the ultimate gathering to celebrate Korean pop music and culture with fellow fans and audiences joined in the high-energy performances, fandom community, and Kpop vibes.



Riding a bicycle through the DMZ

President Kwonsik Kim (80), who founded and runs EVS (Engineering, Value and Service), which is a renewable energy company based in Minnesota, rode his bicycle through the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), which starts from Paju, Gyeonggi-do and continues to Goseong, Gangwon-do, from October 3 to 11. This event was dedicated to a friend who went to South Korea during the 'Heungnam Withdrawal', in which the US military withdrew from South Korea, and put South Korea at a disadvantage due to the intervention of the Chinese army on the Eastern Front in December 1950. When the 'Korean War' was in full swing, the friend rescued a large number of refugees. It was an event created by Dong-myeong Joo (81), an alumnus of Seoul National University's College of Engineering and director of New York City's technology, as he always wanted to go back to his hometown. Kim's acquaintances, Dr. Byung-Hak Lee (64), equipment manager at Entegris (a Minnesota semiconductor company), and Daewon Kim (67), a former Samsung Group executive, went on this ride together.

Kim who led this event, is enjoying a healthy old age thanks to the fact that he has made exercise a part of his daily routine since leaving South Korea to study at the University of Minnesota in 1969. On May 21, 2022 Kim was introduced to health and wellness in an article by a reporter Jong-gu Yang titled "Health Tips for the Age of 100". Even though he is 80 years old, he maintains his health by exercising every day. "Because I was healthy, I was able to cross the Korean Peninsula along the DMZ. I'm happy to be able to go on a meaningful trip with my friends," he said with a bright smile.



2023 Admired Mother Award Young-soon Ryan | Award Recipient

This award was established to honor the life of Mrs. Kyong-ja Lee (1915-2005) who became a widow at the age of 34 during the Korean War and had to overcome indescribable hardships and raise her four children who became successful professionals. This award will be given to those single mothers who are following Mrs. Lee's footsteps to encourage them.

This year, Young-soon Ryan was selected as the 2023 recipient, and the award ceremony was held at the KAAM Center on Saturday, December 16. \$1,000 were awarded to the recipient and KAAM encouraged Youngsoon Ryan for her dedicated life and her hard work to raise her children. She was selected as the 2023 recipient because she raised two healthy and successful children alone in the United States without knowing anyone and any help from others, and she became a wonderful example to her neighbors and community.











Cookin' (Nanta) Show in Minnesota

Cookin' (Nanta 난타), the international Korean smash-hit, sensation, was only offered at Children's Theatre Company in Minneapolis from September 12 - October 22, 2023. The <Nanta> performance, which has been very popular in Korea since the 90s, finally arrived in Minnesota. Cookin' is the longest-running show in South Korea's history (over 1.48 million people have attended performances) and has performed in more than 60 countries throughout Europe, Asia, and North America. It was a high-quality performance that not only allowed everyone from children to adults to laugh and enjoy the show, but also the interaction with the audience made the show more enjoyable. They also offered 15-20% discounts especially for Koreans community and members.

While the cast members stayed in Minnesota for about two months, they were invited by Target Vice President Don Liu and several colleagues to have dinners at a Korean restaurant and a resident family's house, a tourist course around Minneapolis including a Target Corporation tour. The casting members and staff said that they received the most warm welcome in Minnesota and they expressed their gratitude for creating the most beautiful and unforgettable memories of Minnesota.







Visitation from the Consulate General in Chicago

Consul General Jeonghan Kim and Consul General Insoo Kim of Chicago visited Minnesota on Friday, September 29, to congratulate the <Minnesota K-Culture Festival>. President Yong Hyeok Lee, Board chair, Jae-hyun Park, Vice President Julian Kim, and Executive Director Eunah Oh from KAAM were invited to the dinner provided by the Consulate General of Chicago. They attended the event the next day, September 30th at the Mall of America, and then returned to Chicago right after the event. KAAM was very encouraged by their visitation to Minnesota even in the midst of their busy schedules. KAAM will continue to have a good relationship with the Consulate General in Chicago and work with them closely.

The 22nd Overseas Elections



Consulate General of Chicago Chang-ho Woo and Consulate General Rae-yun Park visited the KAAM Center to promote the 22nd Overseas Elections for National Assembly Members. It will be held on April 10, and overseas voting will be held for six days starting March 27.

In order for Korean citizens to exercise their right to vote abroad, they must report and apply as an overseas absentee. Absentees abroad are citizens registered as residents in Korea and include overseas travelers, international students, and expatriates of companies. Overseas voters are citizens of the Republic of Korea who are not citizens of another country and are not registered as residents in Korea. Only Korean nationals who are 18 years of age or older as of election day can participate in the election.

Woo said that he plans to do his best to make voting more convenient and asked KAAM to encourage Korean residents in Minnesota to participate in voting (check website at ova.nec.go.kr).

At the League of Legends (LoL) World Championship Opening Ceremony 2023







Minnesota-based film actor Lee Horam (Brandon Holam Lee, the second son of the KAAM President) performed a wonderful performance with world-class artists such as New Jeans at the LOL Worlds Final competition opening ceremony held at the Gochuk Sky Dome on November 19th. The 'LoL World Championship' final is a sports event that attracts a lot of attention, reaching a peak of 180 million concurrent users (as of 2023) and recording a larger number of viewers than the Super Bowl among sports games (as of 2019). The opening stage of the 'LoL World Championship' finals has featured top artists who have sung past theme songs, including Imagine Dragons (2014) and Lil Nas X (2022). This year, Minnesota native Horam Lee's performance as the lead actor in a joint performance with world-class artists such as top artists like New Jeans, Baekhyun (who is a member of group EXO), HEARTSTEEL, and Mako appeared at the opening event making the celebration even brighter. This opening celebration event was successful.

<Jogakbo > Korean Traditional Patchwork Jaehyun Veenstra | Jogakbo Artist

Jaehyun Veenstra, Jogakbo artist, is currently teaching Korean Traditional Patchwork called Jogakbo in Minnesota. Not only Korean American residents but also other residents from Minnesota are interested in Korean culture. It will be a great opportunity for them to experience Korean culture and discover Korean roots and beauty. As many people inquire and request for more learning opportunities about Jogakbo, the KAAM is also actively promoting Jogakbo and his classes.

Artist Jaehyeon Yang has offered classes at the Hennepin County Library and plans to continue to strive to provide more classes through communication with other regions. Cultural Identity and Self Care Workshop | Hosted by Adoptee_Hub

Adoptee Hub hosted the cultural identity and self-care workshop that promotes self-care and Korean culture on Saturday, November 4 at the Coffman Memorial Union, University of Minnesota. The workshop was an all-day event for adoptees, 18 years of age and older.

Participants were able to join in four different sessions and choose from among topics about yoga and meditation; Korean culture with a traditional tea ceremony; essential Korean language learning; cooking classes that include making kimbap and kimchi; massage therapy; self-defense; and informational sessions on birth search and visiting Korea.



Participants received a free t-shirt and specific items depending upon the session attended. A continental breakfast and a Korean-inspired lunch were also included.

Korean American National Sports Festival

Youngchul Kwon | Vice President, MN Sports Association

The 22nd Korean American National Sports Festival (KANSF) was held in New York from June 23 to 25, 2023, with a total of 3,798 athletes from 32 regions of America participating. About 60 athletes from Minnesota participated in this event including Taejoon Park who is a president of the Minnesota Korean American Sports Association, as a team leader, and Jaehyun Park who is a president of the Minnesota Jokku Association, attended as a co-leader. The Minnesota team participated in four sports (soccer, foot volleyball, golf and tennis), but unfortunately, they ranked in the bottom tier.

The leader Taejoon Park said, "The Korean American communities became one through sports, and we shared valuable memories of cooperation with next generations and Korean pride. Minnesota has been on the periphery of sports in the U.S. until now and will stand up as the center of sports in the U.S. starting with this tournament."

Former president of the Minnesota Sports Association, Hyeongho Han said, "I am very happy for the Minnesota Sports Association that had no event during the pandemic but is now actively participating in the event. Please do your best for the honor of Minnesota".

The KANSF is held every two years in major U.S. cities, originally starting in LA in 1981. New York held the event again for the first time in 40 years and won the championship with the largest number of athletes participating. The Minnesota team plans to prepare diligently for the 23rd KANSF in LA in two years' time with the goal of ranking in the middle tier. We look forward to the active participation and support from the Korean American residents in Minnesota.









MN KCUP Golf Match Jaewon Kim | MN Golf Association Chair

On September 4, 2023, the <MN KCUP> golf tournament was held at Bunker Hills Golf Course. The MN KCUP Match is an event that golfers living in Minnesota form teams and play morning and afternoon matches every year on Labor Day. It was held in the Ryder Cup format, and players are divided by their living regions into eastern and western. Team games were held in the morning and individual games were held in the afternoon. This event first started in 2018 and it was the 6th year. Th east region team won the Championships 4 times in 2018, 2020, 2021 and 2023), and the West region team won the Championship twice in 2019 and 2022. The winning team receives and keeps the MN KCUP Trophy until the next tournament.

This year, a total of 32 male players competed, and for the first time, four female players participated in the exhibition game.

On September 10, 2023, the <Couple Scramble> tournament was held at Chomonix Golf Course. The couple's scramble golf event started for the first time this year, and a total of 10 couples participated. It was conducted in a scramble format with 4 players each.
